


Ireland ZEV targets

- 30% of Private Cars by 2030
- Estimated number of 195,000 plug-in EVs on the road by 2025
- AFIR then requires 325% increase in charging capacity by 2025





Power and charge point capacity



Power increase: 71,000kW to 214,000kW



Charge Point Increase:

2,100 to 3,200 – 6,210 nationally

Depending on need



Charger point every 60Km on the motorway network

300-600kW on Ten T HGV
Infrastructure











Static data

By May 2025, operators of publicly accessible recharging points or the owners of those points must ensure the availability of the following static data:



























Dynamic data

Schemes

- €15m has been allocated to both the Just Transtion Community Fund and the All Island Sport Club Scheme
 - Both schemes are expected to be in procurement by Q2 2024 with delivery commencing thereafter

Vehicles

 Currently, we would expect to have 140,000 to 150,000
 EVs on the road by the end of 2024

Accessibility & Interoperability

- Any new chargers installed from 1 Jan 2024, must have the function to tap and go.
- Anything state funded will be required to meet the universal design standards as appropriate for the location.

Chargers

 Currently, we would expect to have up to 500 fast chargers installed by the end of 2024
